

# Verbo tener: to have

Subject	simple present		simple present (negative)	
<b>yo</b> (I)	<b>tengo</b>	I have	<b>no tengo</b>	I don't have
<b>tu</b> (you familiar singular)	<b> tienes</b>	you have	<b>no tienes</b>	you don't have
<b>ella, el, usted</b> (she, he, you formal singular)	<b>tiene</b>	she has	<b>no tiene</b>	she doesn't have
<b>nosotras/os</b> (we)	<b>tenemos</b>	we have	<b>no tenemos</b>	we don't have
<b>vosotras/os</b> (you familiar plural (fa. p))	<b>tenéis</b>	you have	<b>no tenéis</b>	you (fa.p.) don't have
<b>ellas/os, ustedes</b> (they, you formal plural)	<b>tienen</b>	they have	<b>no tienen</b>	they don't have

Examples:

I have an apple.

Yo **tengo** una manzana.

I have some apples.

Yo **tengo** unas manzanas.

I don't have apples.

Yo **no tengo** manzanas.

I don't have some apples.

Yo **no tengo** manzanas.
